The Company Real Trade Group congratulates you on the 5th place and would like to ask you the following questions:

Please tell us a bit about yourself.

I'm 25 years old, Master of Science (Engineering) student from Helsinki. My hobbies are all scientific stuff, all kinds of sports and Forex-trading of course.

How long have you been trading Forex?

I've been demo-trading for almost 3 years, but live trading less than a year.

How did you find out about the contest run by the Company Real Trade? Did you expect the victory?

I found out about the Real Trade's contest when I was searching for good brokers. I knew that I might have a chance to get to the top 15 and happily got to the top 5.

What is your trading during the contest based on?

I usually prefer a long-term trading - 1d and 4hour charts - but in the contest I used mostly "a shorter variation" of my trading methods. I use technical analysis without Expert Advisors, (including some indicators and R/S + pivot levels)

What strategy do you prefer – a long-term or a short-term? Why?

I prefer a long-term trading. In my opinion, it's less stressful and not as hectic as a short-term trading. Even if it needs bigger stop-losses, I think it's still more reliable.

What currency pair do you prefer to work with? Why?

I prefer EUR/USD (volatile), I also like GBD/USD, and all -/JPY pairs. But I do use other pairs too.

**What kind of means or methods do you use in order to gain knowledge about Forex market?
What would you like to advise beginners?**

a) All I know I have learned from Internet and from lots of demo-trading.

b) Never stop learning. Keep demoing (even if you start live-trading). Try to get the "big picture" of the market (higher time-frames), even if you trade with lower time-frames. "Trend is your friend!" :)
